Year 6 FREE Breakfast Club SATs Week

We are very proud of the effort being made by our Year 6 pupils as they prepare for their SATs and we would like to thank you for your continued support as well. All the children have worked exceptionally hard this year and SATs week is an extremely important time for everyone.

As you know, SATs week begins on Tuesday 9th May (timetable included below and further details in the summer term newsletter). To support the children to come into school and feel relaxed, we will be running a **breakfast club for Year 6 children each morning from 8am**. This will run from Tuesday 9th May until Friday 12th May and there will be **no cost** for your child to attend.
