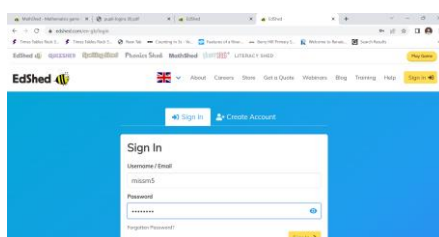


Assignments

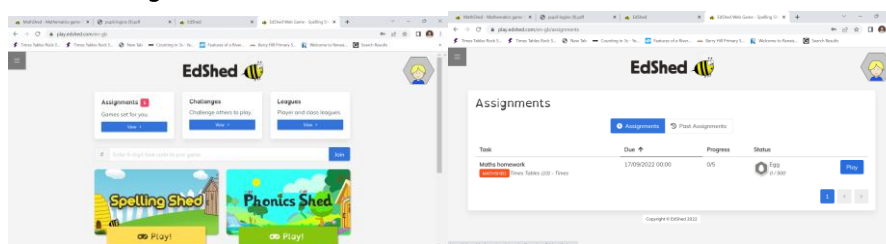
Children will be assigned regular homework on the assignments tab. When your child logs in they should click on assignments to ensure they have completed the homework set each week. **Your child will be asked to complete the assignment set 3 times before it is complete.** This is so that they can attempt the activity at three different levels; easy, medium and hard.

Logging in

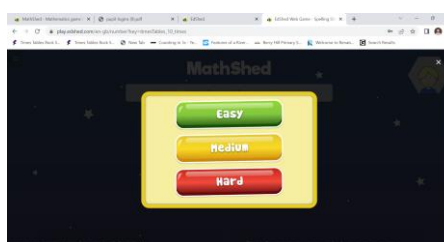
1. Your child's login details can be found in the back of their reading diary on the notes page. They can log into Maths Shed and Spelling Shed by following this link <https://www.edshed.com/en-gb/login> or by scanning the QR code on their login label.



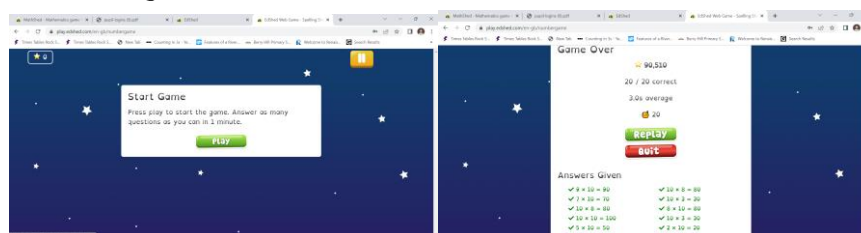
- Once your child has logged in they will see that an assignment has been set and will be able to click on the assignment tab which will take them to their homework for the week.



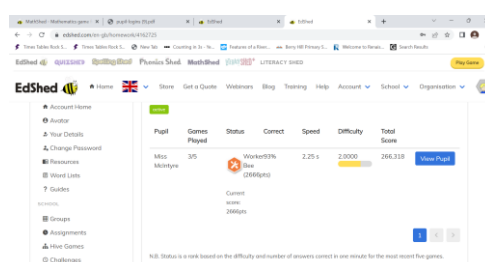
- When they click on the assignment they will be asked to choose their level of difficulty. Each assignment is set 3 times to allow your child to access each level of difficulty. Your child may want to start easy and build up to hard. Equally they may start at medium and if they find it too tricky try easy next time or they might want to challenge themselves further to try hard.



- Your child will be given a time to complete the assignment. Once they have completed the assignment they will be given instant feedback to let them know how they have done.



- Your child's teacher will also be able to keep an eye on how your child is getting on with the assignments being set.
