Dear Parents/Carers

Year Six visit to Wollaton Hall 10th October 2022.

To enrich our Year Six Science curriculum, we have arranged an exciting visit to Wollaton Hall on **Monday, 10th October 2022.** At Wollaton Hall, the children will participate in two workshops that are planned to enrich our curriculum. One will focus on the Victorian fossil collector Mary Anning, where the children will examine specimens, identify different fossils themselves and learn how creatures today have evolved. The second workshop is a tree trail, focusing on classifying and identifying tree specimens. Weather permitting, we will be able to take this newly-acquired knowledge and put it into practice straight away in the beautiful grounds of Wollaton Park!

The cost of the trip is **£17.26 per child** which covers the cost of the coach as well as the fantastic workshops. This needs to be paid through School Money by **Friday 30th September 2022.** **The trip will only be viable if we are able to cover the full cost. Please note that once payment is made we cannot offer refunds.**

On the day, we will leave school around 9:15am and return to school for the children to be collected at the usual time of 3:20pm.

We ask that the children bring packed lunches so that we are able to enjoy a picnic (again, weather permitting). If the weather is not pleasant, we will eat inside. Packed lunches from the school kitchen can be purchased and will be provided free of charge for the children who are eligible for free school meals. These need to be booked and paid for on School Money by **Monday 3rd October 2022 at 12noon.** If they are not booked by this date you will have to provide your child with a packed lunch from home.

School uniform is to be worn for the trip, ensuring this is weather appropriate. Please ensure suitable footwear is also worn and coats provided in case of rain.
