# Welcome back Year 1 Summer term

Dear Families,

We hope you had a wonderful Easter break. The Year 1 team is excited to welcome you back as we begin the Summer term.

## Writing

We will start with the narrative 'Grandad's Island', about Syd's adventure with his Grandad. Then, children will explore the traditional tale 'Little Red Riding Hood' and then write a recount, 'Our Trip to the Woods', about their own woodland adventure.



## Little Wandle

Phonics Screening Check (PSC) Preparation

To prepare for the Phonics Screening Check (PSC) on June 9th, we invite you to attend the 'Preparing for the PSC' meeting on Monday, April 28th.

We assess children every three weeks to identify gaps in GPCs, decodable, and tricky words. Any areas for practice will be sent home with the Little Wandle Home Learning sheet, which outlines the week's content.

Please continue to read with your child at least three times a week and sign their diary.



## Maths

We will begin by introducing multiplication and division, focusing on counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. As mentioned last term, using Numbots at home is a great way to improve quick recall and fluency. Logins can be found in the back of your child's reading diary.



## Science

In this unit, the children will explore the topic of plants and learn about the plants in their local area.

They will understand the parts of a plant and be able to label a diagram.



## PHSE

We will cover Water Spillages, teaching children how to be responsible in preventing spills. Then, we will focus on Hazard Watch, helping children understand how to identify and stay safe from potential hazards.

## Humanities



We will explore 'What is it like in Shanghai?', helping children understand the human and physical features of the city and compare them to their own local area.

Next term, we will study 'What was the Great Fire of London?' and its impact (events beyond living memory). We'll also have an exciting workshop with engaging activities throughout the day.

## RE

We will continue with Stories of Jesus (Christianity) – What can we learn from them? How do they impact lives? Then, we'll explore the importance of churches and synagogues (Christianity and Judaism).

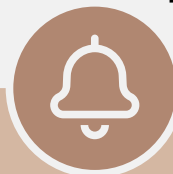
## Art /DT

The children will be inspired by Clarice Cliff's style, using paint to explore secondary colours. In Design and Technology the children will explore fruit and vegetable smoothies. Pupils will combine their ingredients, evaluate their product, and design packaging for their smoothie.



## Computing

In computing, we will be completing our "Rocket to the Moon" unit, which involves using computers, we will revisit the importance of staying safe online.
