The summer term of Year 6 is always packed, and this year promises to be a fun-filled one! As the children enter their final term of primary school, we aim to help them make even more lasting memories of their time here at Berry Hill

### English

In English, we will be studying *The Haunting of Aveline Jones*, which is a spooky tale set in a sleepy coastal town. The children will continue to work on developing their writing and showcasing many of the skills they have honed this year. We continue to follow Accelerated Reader for levelled reading books, and we recommend that children read for 20 minutes a day.

### Maths

After the SATs examinations, Year 6 will learn more about statistics, shape, and carry out wider investigations and problem solving. We will continue to revise the core skills taught at KS2 to ensure children continue to embed their mathematical foundations before moving to their new schools.

### Science

This summer in Science, we will continue our unit about living things and their habitats, then move onto learning about how human and animal bodies work. We will be focusing on the circulatory system and the crucial role that the heart, lungs and blood vessel play.

### PE

PE will be taught on a Tuesday and Wednesday. The children should come to school dressed in their PE kit. A reminder of the PE kit is on our class page on the website. The first sports for Year Six will be Athletics and Tennis.

### History

For History, we are focusing on comparing the similarities and differences between the Mayan, Ancient Egyptian and Roman civilisations. The children will be working like historians by using timelines and analysing sources. To finish the topic, they will conclude which civilisation built the best society by looking at the legacy.

### PSHE/RSE

We will focus on staying safe. We will think about how we can stay safe around water and exploring the dangers of alcohol. Then, we will move onto our unit on growing, changing and conception. More information will be sent home about this final unit nearer the time.

### Performance

We are very excited to announce that Year 6 will put on a drama production at the end of the summer term. We will be working hard on the production, and we look forward to seeing them take to the stage (more information to follow nearer the time).

### Residential

As you will be aware, the Year 6 residential will take place on 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June. There will be a meeting and more information about this visit nearer the time.

### Transition

Year 6 will be involved in a range of activities designed to ease transition to secondary school. We will run activities with the children focused on building confidence and resilience, aiming to alleviate their concerns. Secondary schools run their own transition, and they will contact you directly.
